

Dmitrii Kim was born 19.02.2002 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan and when he was 11, the family moved to Kaluga, Russia. He began studying music at the age of 8. Now he is studying in Kaluga Regional Musical College named after Sergey Taneyev by Elena Minkova, the head of the piano department in this College and Honored Worker of Culture.

Dima is laureate of international competitions – “Masterpieces of piano music” (2018, 1st prize, Moscow), “Vocation - Musician” (2019, 1st prize, Moscow). He is a participant of concert programs of the V. Spivakov International Charitable Foundation (since 2018). He performed under the auspices of the Foundation in Paris in May 2018 in the UNESCO Representation Office of the Russian Federation, in the Moscow International House of Music (Chamber Hall), In the Literary Museum named after A.Pushkin, in the A.Shilov Gallery. He is the owner of the nominal scholarship of the Government of the Kaluga region named after N.P. Rakov (2015, 2017, 2018 and 2019). The Found «KunstKreisLuzern» plays an important role in his life. In 2018 Dima visited Switzerland and had there wonderful master-classes with a final recital.
